Both ancient felt technologies of the people of Central Asia and the innovative method of "nuno-felting" were used in the production of the clothing line. Also local ecologically clean natural raw materials produced in Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan: sheep wool, silk clothes, vegetable dyes.

The ring (Kush tumsyk – Bird's beak) is crafted in the traditional Kazakh form. It was passed from mother to daughter and carried a deep sacred meaning. The ring symbolizes the creation of a family and procreation









RING "SINGING DUNE"

AIZHAN TLENBEKOVA, A.TLENBEK STUDIO

This silver ring is dedicated to a unique place in Almaty region – the "Singing Dune". The dune made of light-colored sand, has a length of up to 3 km and a height of 150m. The singing dune is a natural phenomenon, famous for the fact that in dry weather the sands emit a sound similar to the melody of a ringing organ.









"UYA" SILVER BRACELET AND EARRINGS

KAZAKHSTAN

BOTAGOZ ZEINISHEVA, ASSYLBEK ZEINISHEV

The product is made of silver with natural minerals (turquoise, chrysoprase, carnelian, chrysotile). The bracelet and earrings are made of locally produced recycled silver. Minerals used in this product are mined and cut in Kazakhstan. Bracelet and earrings traditionally, from time immemorial were worn by Kazakh women.









WOMEN'S ETHNO HAT

Kazakh women's hat - an echo of the steppe and the path of golden embroidery. This type of headdress was called Kasaba and was worn mainly by women in the after their marriage and in some cases over a Kimeshek and a scarf.


